**Question:** if a person has daughters is it imperative that he scrutinise the suitor if he presents himself for marriage to his daughters or should he just put his trust in Allaah?

**Shaykh Saalih al-Fawzaan** (حفظه الله)<sup>1</sup>: He should put his trust in Allaah, and become acquainted with the suitor, and get to know his condition as it relates to his religion, his trustworthiness, and his righteousness. And he should ask about him, asking those who accompany him, travel with him and know him.
